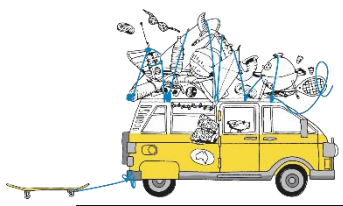

The El Cadejo range from Viña Santa Alicia in Pirqu , a few miles south of Santiago. The range comprises of a Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. This selection offers unbeatable value and continues to attract increased listings and sales growth.

The most up to date technology compliments the elegance and tradition of the Santa Alicia Winery. Boasting the first, quality European machine process, filter and bottler, the wines are produced to extremely high standards. There is, however, no technology that surpasses the aromatic charm given by the barrels of American oak, and the sweet delicacy of tannins from the French oak, used with the winemakers great skill for the Reserva range.



Vignerons de Bel Air encourage the best winemaking practices adjusted for each region and always remain true to their mission; a good wine is a good grape and each vintage is a new challenge.

They consist of 250 winegrowers over 700 hectares of Gamay and Chardonnay vines.

The diversity of the soils, the exposure, the altitude and the age (some of their vines are hundred years old) bring to them a very large range of terroirs.



Over the past two centuries, the family owned Château Bertinerie has selected the best terrains that suit the traditional grape varieties grown in the Bordeaux area.

For over 30 years, the Bantegnies family have been using a method of sustainable viticulture called Reasoned Agriculture (“lutte raisonnée”), which produces wine without residual chemical traces. Furthermore the wine treatment products used are all biodegradable.





LES FRÈRES LAFFITTE — GASCONY, FRANCE

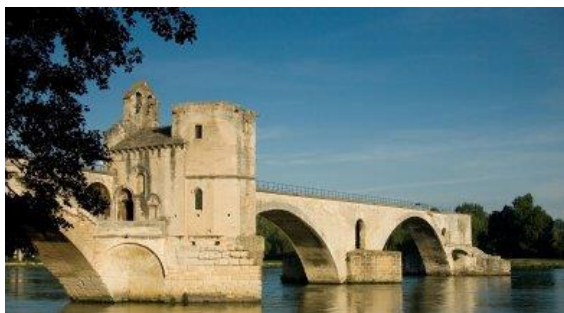


Les Freres Laffitte are two brothers living in Gascony. Their family Laffitte have lived on these territories since Medieval Time. Throughout the years there has only always been one son. This is why the property has been passed on from father to son throughout the generations. Now, for the first time there are 2 sons, Christophe and Sebastien Laffitte.

The two brothers working together is where the idea of the tandem comes from. Domaine Laffitte is joyous and fun like the people of Gascon. With the goose referring to Sebastien who is big and strong. The duck is Christophe, smaller but also very important in Gascony.

Domaine Laffitte grow their vines in a traditional way that is in respect of their environment which is dear to them. They practice green manure seedlings every year to limit winter erosion and increase soil fertility. All their work has one and only one goal - to produce the best grapes.





Founded in 1963 with a collaboration of winegrowers from the Rhone region, and strengthened by its partnerships of which included twenty historic areas and castles, Vignobles & Compagnie is specialised in the selection and marketing of wines from the Rhone Valley.

The Clear Mountain range are great varietal examples from the Western Cape of South Africa.

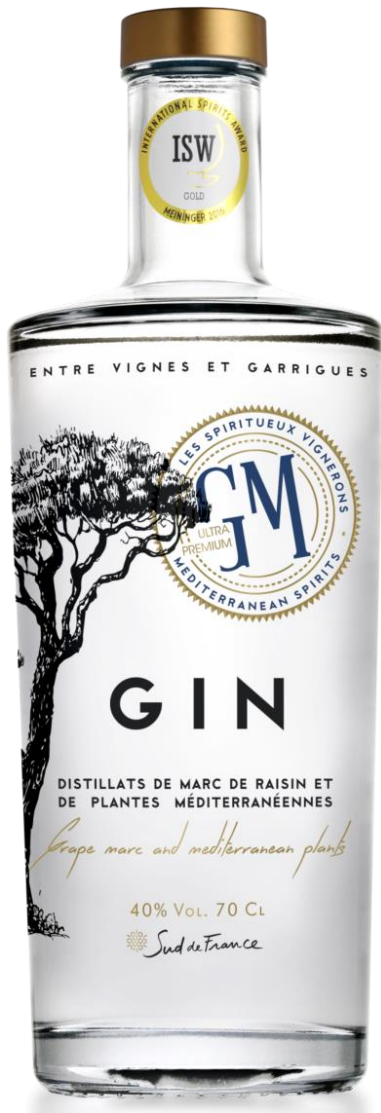

LA GRAPPE DE MONTPELLIER

Depuis 1923

Gin of grape marc and mediterranean plants – 40°

ORIGIN

An alcohol from grape marc coming from a selection of regions and grape varieties in Languedoc-Roussillon. The distillates of juniper berries and of Mediterranean plants.

DISTILLATION

Five successive columns enable the spirit to be extracted from the grape marc, then concentrated and rectified so as to remove any trace of methanol. The last refining column, entirely made from copper, enables the aromas of the grape marc to come through. Juniper berries and a bouquet of plants from our Mediterranean garrigues are distilled in a traditional way to give a unique identity to this gin: lemon zest, bitter almond, coriander, lavender, grape ...

TASTING

An ultra-premium crystalline product, obtained from a superfine alcohol that doesn't burn in the mouth, this gin subtly and elegantly reveals a whole universe of Mediterranean scents. A walk through the heart of the garrigue.
